#### SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The National Association of Minority Contractors (NAMC) Greater Atlanta Chapter offers scholarships to college students pursuing degrees related to construction, architecture, and engineering. The \$2,500 scholarship awards are paid directly to the recipient's college to be applied towards their tuition and fees.

NAMC has its roots dating back to 1969 when over 300 minority contractors, including Atlanta's R.A. Banks, convened in San Francisco to discuss strategies for gaining more access to the mainstream construction industry. This meeting led to the formation of NAMC. In the early 1970s, prominent Atlanta contractors like Herman J. Russell, R.A. Banks, E.R. Mitchell, Sr., and Floyd O. Thacker established the Greater Atlanta Chapter to further NAMC's national goals locally

Today, NAMC's mission remains to provide advocacy, education, and training, maintaining a voice in government affairs both locally and federally which impact the industry, and increasing minority contractors' market share in construction.

Committed to educating and cultivating future leaders, NAMC Greater Atlanta invites college students majoring in construction, architecture, or engineering-related fields to apply for these scholarships. The Executive Committee will review all applications. Scholarship recipients will be notified on June 12, 2024, and will be invited as honored guests to attend NAMC's Construction Inclusion Week in October 2024, or the 2024 Hall of Fame Gala during the NAMC National Conference at the Signia by Hilton Hotel in Atlanta, Georgia

### DIVERSITY, EQUITY, AND INCLUSION

NAMC believes diversity, equity, and inclusion are key to NAMC's values, and are critical to our success and future as a leading community advocacy organization. We are committed to equal opportunity for all. We are looking to attract the best and most diverse student talent to advance the construction industry.

All college students enrolled and seeking a scholarship from the NAMC Greater Atlanta Chapter must complete the application and provide the requested information. Doing so may increase opportunities for scholarships where sponsors have specified that priority consideration should be given to students meeting certain criteria, such as minority status or particular fields of study. Providing complete information ensures applicants are fully considered for all eligible scholarship opportunities.



#### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

- 1. Must have completed a minimum of one (1) full academic year of studies, and have a minimum of one additional academic year remaining before earning their degree..
- 2. Must be enrolled in an A/E/C degree program, or other related degree program. Examples of eligible degree programs include, but are not limited to, architecture, engineering (civil, mechanical, structural, etc.), and construction management.

#### NAMC GREATER ATLANTA SCHOLARSHIP REVIEW PROCESS

The NAMC Greater Atlanta Executive Committee will evaluate all complete applications received. A points-based scoring system will be used to assess each application for the scholarship award. The total possible points are indicated for specific tasks or questions. Applicants must answer all questions. If a question does not apply to your situation, write "N/A" in the provided space and briefly explain why it is not applicable.

Scholarship recipients will be notified on June 12, 2024, and invited as guests to attend NAMC Greater Atlanta's Construction Inclusion Week in October 2024 or the 2024 Hall of Fame Gala. While not mandatory, scholarship winners are strongly encouraged to be present at the designated NAMC Greater Atlanta event, where they will be recognized and presented with their scholarship award checks. The event location details will be provided with the invitation.

#### **HELPFUL HINTS**

- All sections of the application must be completed in full and submitted electronically or by mail before the April 30, 2024 deadline.
- An application submitted missing any of the sections and without a signature will be disqualified from consideration.
- The response to the essay must be typed. Be sure to check spelling and grammar carefully.
- Please remember that your application will be scanned and disseminated to the selection committee electronically; presentation is important.
- The subject line of your email when submitting should include NAMC Scholarship, your last name and school name.
- Please submit one email with all completed sections of the application, preferably in one PDF document.
- Please keep a copy of your complete application package and request proof of electronic delivery. The returned proof of delivery will serve as verification that your application has been received. No additional notification will be provided.
