



SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The NAMC Georgia Chapter scholarship will be awarded to enrolled college students who are pursuing studies in or related to the Construction, Architecture and Engineering. Scholarships awards are \$2500 each and payable to the applicant's college registrar to be applied to the student's account.

In 1969 more than 300 minority contractors, including Atlanta's R. A. Banks, met in San Francisco to gather forces and discuss ways to help them enter the mainstream of the construction industry. By the conclusion of the meeting, the National Association of Minority Contractors was conceived. In the early 70's, leading Atlanta contractors, Herman J. Russell, R. A. Banks, E. R. Mitchell, Sr., Floyd O. Thacker and others joined to form the Atlanta Chapter to further the goals established by the national coalition.

The goals of NAMC today remain the same: provide advocacy, education, and training; to maintain a voice in Washington, D.C. and the State relative to our needs; and to increase our market share and position in the construction industry.

In the spirit of education and a commitment to our future leaders, we are inviting college students who have declared their majors in the aforementioned fields of study to apply for our scholarships. Applications will be reviewed by the NAMC Executive Committee. The winning recipients will be notified January, 10, 2022 and invited as guests to our New Year Kick-Off Mixer on January 13, 2022. The location will be determined later.
